

## Terms and Conditions

### 1. Subject

Just Ride Technologies OÜ has developed a carpooling platform Greta carpool accessible on a mobile application, and designed to put drivers travelling to a given destination in contact with passengers going in the same direction, in order to enable them to share the ride and therefore the associated costs.

These terms and conditions have the purpose of governing access to and the terms of use of the Greta carpool app. Please read them carefully. You understand and recognise that Just Ride Technologies is not party to any agreement, contract or contractual relations, of any nature, entered into between the members of its application.

### 2. Agreement

By clicking "Login with Facebook", you recognise having read and accepted all these general conditions of use.

### 3. Registration on the Greta carpool app and creation of an account

#### 3.1. Conditions of registration on the Greta carpool app

The Greta carpool app may be used by individuals aged 16 or over. In accessing, using or registering on the Greta carpool app, you represent and warrant that you are aged 16 or over.

#### 3.2. Creation of an Account

The Greta carpool app enables Members to post and view rides and to interact with each other to book a seat. You can not view the rides if you are not registered on the Greta carpool app. To create your Account, you can:

Log in to your Facebook account via Greta carpool app (hereinafter referred to as your "Facebook Account"). In using such functionality, you understand that Just Ride Technologies will have access to, will publish on the Greta carpool app, and will keep certain information from your Facebook Account. If you wish to find out more about the use of your data from your Facebook Account, read our Privacy Policy and that of Facebook.

To register on the Greta carpool app, you must have read and accepted these T&Cs and the Privacy Policy.

You agree not to create or use, under your own identity or that of a third party, Accounts other than that initially created.

## 4. Use of the Services

### 4.1. Posting Adverts

As a registered member you can create and post rides on the Greta carpool app by entering information about the trip you intend to make (dates/times and collection points and arrival, number of seats offered, options available, amount of the cost contribution, etc.).

You are only authorised to post an ride if you fulfil all the following conditions:

- (i) you hold a valid driving licence;
- (ii) you only offer rides for vehicles you own or use with the express permission of the owner, and in all cases that you are authorised to use for the purposes of carpooling;
- (iii) you are and remain the main driver of the vehicle subject of the ride;
- (iv) the vehicle has valid third party insurance;
- (v) you have no contraindication or medical incapacity for driving;
- (vi) the vehicle you intend to use for the Trip is a touring car with 4 wheels and a maximum of 7 seats;
- (vii) you do not intend posting another advert for the same ride on the Greta carpool app;
- (viii) you do not offer more seats than the number available in your vehicle;
- (ix) all seats offered have a seatbelt, even if the vehicle is approved with seats having no seatbelt;
- (x) to use a vehicle in good working order and which complies with the applicable legal provisions and customs

You recognise that you are solely responsible for the content of the ride you post on the Greta carpool app. Consequently, you represent and warrant the accuracy and truthfulness of all information contained in your ride, and you undertake to fulfil the ride under the conditions described in your uploaded ride.

Providing your Advert complies with the T&Cs, it will be posted on the Greta carpool app and therefore visible to members conducting a search on the Greta carpool app. Just Ride Technologies reserves the right, at its sole discretion and without notice, to not post or to remove, at any time, any Advert that does not comply with the T&Cs or that it considers as damaging to its image, that of the Greta carpool app, or that of the Services.

### 4.2. Booking a Seat

A Facebook registered member can book a seat using the Greta carpool app.

When a passenger is interested in a ride, he may make a booking request through the Greta carpool app. This Booking request is accepted manually by the driver.

## 5. Non-commercial and non-business purpose of the Services and the Greta carpool app

You agree to use the Services and the Greta carpool app only to be put into contact, on a non-business and non-commercial basis, with people wishing to share a Trip with you.

As a driver, you agree not to request a cost contribution higher than the costs you actually incur and that may generate a profit, being specified that in the context of a cost sharing, you have to bear as a driver your own part of the costs induced by the trip. You are solely responsible for calculating the costs you incur for the trip and for checking that the amount requested of your passengers does not exceed the costs you actually incur (excluding your share of the costs).

Just Ride Technologies reserves the right to suspend your account in the case where you use a chauffeur-driven or other business vehicle or taxi, or a company car, and due to this, generate a profit from the Greta carpool app.

## 6. Behaviour of users on Greta carpool app

You recognise being solely responsible for respecting all laws, regulations and obligations applicable to your use of the Greta carpool app.

### 6.1. Undertaking of members:

- (i) not to use the Greta carpool app for professional, commercial or profit-making purposes;
- (ii) not to send Just Ride Technologies or the other members any false, misleading, malicious or fraudulent information;
- (iii) not to speak or behave in any way or post any content on the Greta carpool app of a defamatory, injurious, obscene, pornographic, vulgar, offensive, aggressive, uncalled-for, violent, threatening, harassing, racist or xenophobic nature, or with sexual connotations, inciting violence, discrimination or hatred, encouraging activities or the use of illegal substances, or more generally contrary to the purposes of the Greta carpool app, that may infringe the rights of Just Ride Technologies or a third party or contrary to good morals;
- (iv) not to infringe the rights and image of Just Ride Technologies, notably its intellectual property rights;
- (v) not to open more than one account on the Greta carpool app and not to open an account in the name of a third party;

### 6.2. Undertakings of the Drivers:

- (i) to respect all laws, regulations and codes applicable to driving and the vehicle, notably to hold civil liability insurance valid at the time of the trip and to be in possession of a valid driving licence;
- (ii) to check that your insurance covers carpooling

- (iii) not to take any risk when driving, not to take any product that may impair your attention and your abilities to drive vigilantly and completely safely;
- (iv) to post rides corresponding only to the ones actually planned;
- (v) to make the rides as described and to respect the times and places agreed with the other Members (notably meeting place and drop-off point);
- (vi) not to take more passengers than the number of seats indicated in the ride posted;
- (vii) to use a vehicle in good working order and which complies with the applicable legal provisions and customs
- (viii) to communicate to Just Ride Technologies or any passenger who so requests your driving licence, your car registration certificate, your insurance certificate, and any document demonstrating your capacity to use the vehicle as driver on the Greta carpool app;
- (ix) in the case of holdup or change to the time or the ride, to inform your Passengers without delay;
  
- (x) to wait for Passengers at the agreed meeting place for at least 15 minutes after the agreed time;
- (xi) not to post an ride relative to a vehicle you do not own or that you are not authorised to use for the purposes of carpooling;
- (xii) to behave appropriately and responsibly during the ride, and in compliance with the spirit of carpooling;

### 6.3. Undertakings of the passengers:

- (i) to adopt appropriate behaviour during the ride so as not to hinder the concentration or driving of the driver or the peace and quiet of the other Passengers;
- (ii) to respect the driver's vehicle and its cleanliness;
- (iii) in the case of holdup, to inform the driver without delay;
- (iv) to wait for the driver at the meeting place for at least 15 minutes beyond the agreed time;
- (v) to communicate to Just Ride Technologies, or any driver who so asks, your identity card or any document evidencing your identity;

## 7. Personal data

In the context of your use of the Greta carpool app, Just Ride Technologies will collect and process some of your personal data. In using the Greta carpool app and registering an account, you recognise and accept the processing of your personal data by Just Ride Technologies in compliance with the applicable law and the stipulations of the Privacy Policy.

## 8. Intellectual property

Content published by Just Ride Technologies

Subject to the contents provided by its members, Just Ride Technologies is the sole holder of all intellectual property rights relating to Greta carpool app, its content (notably texts, images, designs, logos, videos, sounds, data, graphics) and to the software and databases ensuring their operation.

Just Ride Technologies grants you a non-exclusive, personal and non-transferable right to use the Greta carpool app for your personal and private use, on a non-commercial basis and in compliance with the purposes of the Greta carpool app.

#### 9. Role of Just Ride Technologies and Greta carpool app

The Greta carpool app constitutes an online networking platform on which the users can create and post rides for the purposes of carpooling. These rides can notably be viewed by the other members to find out the terms of the ride and to book a seat.

In using the Greta carpool app and in accepting these T&Cs, you recognise that Just Ride Technologies is not party to any agreement entered into between you and the other members with a view to sharing the costs relating to a Trip.

Just Ride Technologies has no control over the behaviour of its members and the users of the Greta carpool app. It does not own, exploit, supply or manage the vehicles subject of the rides, and it does not offer any rides.

You recognise and accept that Just Ride Technologies does not control the validity, truthfulness or legality of the rides and seats offered. In its capacity of carpooling intermediary, Just Ride Technologies does not provide any transport service and does not act in the capacity of carrier; the role of Just Ride Technologies is limited to facilitating access to the Greta carpool app.

#### 10. Operation, availability and functionalities of the Greta carpool app

Just Ride Technologies will do its best to maintain the Greta carpool app accessible 7 days a week and 24 hours a day. Nevertheless, access to the Greta carpool app may be temporarily suspended, without notice, owing to technical maintenance, migration or update operations, or owing to outages or constraints linked to the operation of the network.

#### 11. Applicable law – Dispute

These T&Cs are written in English and subject to English law.

You can also, if necessary, present your complaints relative to our Greta carpool app or our services on the dispute resolution platform placed online by the European Commission. The European Commission will send your complaint to the competent national ombudsman. In compliance with the rules applicable to mediation, you are bound, before any request for mediation, to have notified Just Ride Technologies in writing of any dispute in order to obtain an amicable solution.

The Greta carpool app is published by Just Ride Technologies OÜ registered with the Companies Register of Estonia with the registry code 14970587, with its registered office at Raua 51-1, Tallinn 10152, Estonia.
